Edenred Benefits

Starting <u>March 5, 2024</u>, all Commuter Benefit Plan enrollments and election changes must be made with Edenred Benefits. You should familiarize yourself with the new Edenred Benefits site as soon as possible on or after March 5. To set up your Edenred Benefits account:

- On or after March 5, 2024, go to <u>https://login.edenredbenefits.com/</u>, choose Employee, click next, and then click on "New User Sign Up." Enter METRO when asked for the Company ID and click next to create your log-in.
- Review your order to ensure accuracy. Your order will show on your dashboard as soon as you log-in.

The **FIRST** benefit month with **Edenred** is May, which means...

- The first day to make changes to your elections for May through Edenred is March 5, 2024.
- The last day to make changes to your elections for May through Edenred is April 4, 2024.
- Edenred will mail a new commuter card to your mailing address on file between April 25-April 30, which will be ready for use on May 1.

The LAST benefit month with HealthEquity/WageWorks is April, which means...

- The last day to make changes to your elections for April through the HealthEquity site is March 4, 2024.
- The last day to use your HealthEquity debit card, commuting passes or submit claim reimbursements to HealthEquity is April 30.
- You should continue to use the HealthEquity/WageWorks site, (wageworks.com) to view balances and submit claim reimbursements through **April 30, 2024.** All pre-tax balances remaining after April 30 will be moved over to your new Edenred Benefits account at the end of May. Post-tax balances will be returned to you.
